Elizabeth Saewyc is Professor and Director of the School of Nursing at the University of British Columbia in Vancouver; she also heads the multidisciplinary Stigma and Resilience Among Vulnerable Youth Centre. For over 20 years, her research and clinical practice has focused on how stigma, violence, and trauma influence adolescents' health, coping and risk behaviours, and what protective factors can foster resilience for: LGBTQ adolescents, homeless, runaway and street-involved youth, sexually abused/exploited teens, immigrants and refugees, and Indigenous youth in multiple countries. Her work has influenced practice, policies, and laws to support adolescent health internationally.
